Committee members re-elected were Claire Murty (Chairperson) and Emma Christou (Treasurer). Gee Andrews stood down as secretary and Stella Nicolaou was elected as new secretary. One of the most exciting projects discussed was the possibility of demolishing the current portakabin that houses the music block and erecting a 2 storey building to house a before and after school club as well as music room. This remains a “pie in the sky” wish for now but Mrs Worby is looking into progressing this and if it can be done and part funded by the FHWS this would not only provide vital facilities for school parents but also give the school a guaranteed income that could be in excess of £60k per year. The school could then use this income to fund teaching posts– something we as FHWS cannot do as our income year on year is not guaranteed.

We will update you as we can but please be assured this will not impact on the purchases we are committed to making to enhance the children’s education.
